Dress Shoes

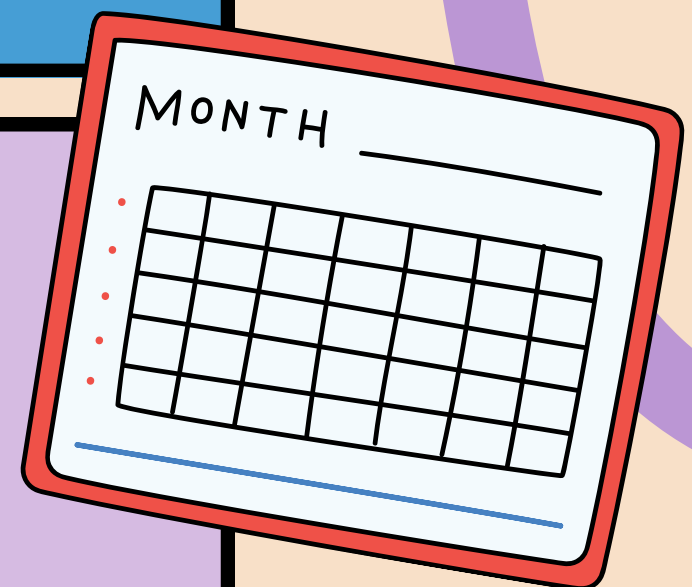


## SPECIAL EVENTS

## NOT PERMITTED

- Super baggy, sagging, or low waisted bottoms
- Rips in pants- no exposed skin above the knee

- Low cut, tight, ripped, slits in shirts
